THE FORMATION OF a student discipline committee was also approved by the board.

The purpose of the committee is to review board policies and regulations set up by the administration, assess the attitudes of high school and middle school students and recommend items for policies and regulations. Dunkin recommended that the committee be made up of Wilkins, Roehr, two or three teachers from both the middle school and high

school, parents, representatives of the Parent-Teacher Organization, juniors and seniors in high school, middle school students and school board member.

Madden volunteered to represent the board on the committee.

In other action, the board:

-approved the purchase of a used vehicle for \$750 to replace the car presently used by elementary staff members in traveling to Otley and Leighton;

-accepted the resignations of three teachers who had one-year assignments; and
