The City Council of the City of Pella, Iowa, met in regular session at the City Office at 7:30 p.m., Mayor Caldwell presiding. Members present were: De Jong, Vandevort, Den Adel, Lent, Klyn. Absent: Menninga.

Approved the minutes of the regular meeting of July 3, 1984.

Approved an application for the renewal of the Class C Beer Permit from Hy Vee Food Stores, Inc.

Approved an application for the renewal of the Class C and Sunday Beer Permits from Grootveld Oil Company dba Stop and Go Quick Shoppe.

Filed for information a letter from the Pella Civil Service Commission certifying an eligible list for the office of Assistant Chief of Police.

Filed for information a letter from Garden & Associates providing the certificate of completion and final plats and schedules for the 1983 Paving Project.

Referred to the Finance Committee letters of audit proposal from Schurling & Ultermarkt and Jeffrey Van Maanen.

Adopted Resolution No. 1733, entitled, "RESOLUTION ADOPTING WORK."

Adopted Resolution No. 1734, entitled, "RESOLUTION ORDERING PREPARATION OF FINAL PLAT AND SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS".

Adopted Resolution No. 1735, entitled, "RESOLUTION ADOPTING FINAL SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF".

Adopted Personnel Committee's recommendation that the city appeal the Job Service decision in the Kroes unemployment insurance case to the District Court and that labor attorney James Klay be enlisted to assist the City Attorney in the case.

Decided that, if the two parties involved in the dispute concerning the no parking ordinance on Lincoln Street would meet with the Public Safety Committee in an attempt to settle the matter, the ordinance would be dropped.

Approved an entrance route for RAGBRAI through the business district of the city on their way to the camping area at the school complex and Swimming Pool Park.

Filed for information the June report of the Ambulance Service.

Approved an estimated cost for renovation of the electric plant cooling tower at a cost of \$20,302.66.

Approved Electric Plant Superintendent Young's request for permission to investigate disposal of an inoperative boiler.

Police Chief outlined street closings in connection with RAGBRAI. Franklin between Main and Broadway would be closed from at least 5:00 until 11:00 p.m. on July 25 and the following street would be closed from 9:00 a.m. on July 25 until 9:00 a.m. on July 26: University from Farmer to East 8th, East 8th from Peace to University and Pool Drive from Prairie to University. Pella Jaycees will be manning the barricades in cases of emergency.

Referred to Public Works Committee Ron Nell's request for an investigation into the type of refuse disposal equipment to be purchased so that a decision could be reached before the present equipment is completely worn out.
