

Number of Left-Handed Students in Pella Public Schools Above Average

The number of left-handed pupils in the Pella schools runs three times as high as the national average, according to a survey recently released by Supt. C. C. Buerskens. "Southpaws" number 96 out of 780 pupils or slightly more than 12 percent. The boys outnumber the girls 55 to 41.

A breakdown by buildings shows 12.4 percent in high school, 13 percent at Webster, and 10.3 percent at Lincoln. Grade 4 at Webster with 22 percent is slightly ahead of the same grade at Lincoln with 21 percent. These two grades have the highest percentage of left-handedness in the system. The freshmen in high school rate 17.4 percent, sophomores 12 percent, juniors 11 percent, and seniors 8 percent.

In Tot Ranks, Too
A study of the situation in kindergarten indicates that the picture in Pella schools is not likely to change very soon. The percentage of beginners in this department with left-handed tendencies is between 12 and 13 percent.

"Identification of left-handed children is not usually difficult. Daily observation by the teacher usually results in determining their laterality quite early." So states Clare Hume, Superintendent of the School for the Deaf in Saksaskana, Canada. "Left-handed children can and should write as easily and as well as any right-handed person. It is the

responsibility of parents and teachers to bring this about."

Controversy
The old controversy as to whether or not a child's nervous stability will be upset or his speech fluency impeded through efforts to change his handedness has still not been settled. Most schools adopt the principle that about 4 percent of all people are left-handed and the nothing can be gained by trying to make them otherwise. The task of parents and teachers thus becomes one of helping the left-handed child become a good left-hander. Casual, everyday observation of clerks, business people, waiters or other leads one to conclude that the schools have not given sufficient help to left-handed writers. The many varieties of left-handed "hook" are to be deplored from the standpoint of comfort, body posture and appearance, even though in many cases the legibility is just as good as that of a right-hander.

A Fair Break
The Pella schools for many years have made it a practice to equip the classrooms and grades with furniture and desks especially adapted to the particular needs of the left-hander. In the high school especially, many of the chairs and desks are equipped with the left-hand tablet arms on the left. In addition, several special practices have been adopted in the grades to see that "port-strides" get a fair break in our school.

Farm Bureau Set Up Research Group To Study Cost of Marketing Meats

The Iowa Farm Bureau, on February 3rd, announced details of a major livestock research project aimed at "obtaining bargaining power for the farmer in the market place, and thus to improve his income."

Studies will be made across the entire area of meat production, processing, distribution and sales, in an effort to determine the causes of the growing "spread" between farm and consumer prices.

Hill's Statement
In announcing the action taken today by the Farm Bureau directors, J. B. Hill, president, said: "Farm Bureau has worked for many years at a many sided approach to the livestock business. We have started and supported promotional efforts; have carried an educational program on the meat-type hog; have struggled with packers to obtain a price bonus for quality meat. We have worked closely with producer associations, and our county livestock committees have been active. We have lobbied for disease control legislation.

"In spite of real progress in most of these areas, the farmer's share of the meat dollar continues to decline. Our members have been asking for answers on the spread."

To Assess Mark-up
"Lacking such material from other sources, the Iowa Farm Bureau has undertaken an intensive, and expensive, project to assess the 'mark-up' in the several distributive steps. We are not 'Hill' concluded, 'interested in witch-hunts. But we are convinced that both the consumer and the farmer would reap tremendous benefits if a more streamlined and more economical movement of meat can be developed."

He hopes to seek out areas where modernized methods would reduce the spread. And we feel that, as a major independent farm organization, we are the logical people to undertake the necessary research."

Corporation Set Up
Board action committee included the filing of incorporation papers for an affiliate of the Iowa Farm Bureau Federation, to be called the Iowa Marketing Research Corporation, the employment of Reynold Hughes, a long-time top official of a major meat packing firm, to direct the research effort, and the agreement that initial studies be made on the processing and distribution of pork.

The research effort, discussed widely by Farm Bureau members as a needed addition to the Bureau's livestock program, was authorized by delegates from the counties at the recent state convention.

Hughes, one-time manager of two packing plants in the midwest and more recently the chief of a team of American specialists who developed and built a packing industry in Turkey, expects to get the research effort underway this month.

Following the comprehensive studies, the Research Corporation will recommend to the Farm Bureau such steps as may seem indicated to improve the position of the livestock producer in the meat industry.

Erosion Is Much Less on Land with Thick Green Cover

HERMAN DE BONDT

Herman De Bondt, 98, died at 9 a.m., Wednesday, February 1st, at the Community Hospital in Grinnell. Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Friday at the James Funeral Home in Grinnell with burial in Kellogg.

Mr. De Bondt, who had been living at a Grinnell Nursing Home, was born in Holland Oct. 26, 1877 and came to America at the age of seven.

One of Jasper County's oldest residents, he is survived by two sons, Henry De Bondt of Grinnell and John De Bondt of Des Moines, six grandchildren and several great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, the former Elizabeth Barendrecht, whom he married in 1886 and by his second wife, the former Minnie Brown, whom he married in 1892; also by two daughters, Mrs. Carrie Antle of Killduff and Mrs. Anna Myers of Newton.

At the time of his death, he was a member of First Methodist Church in Newton, but was a charter member of the First Christian Reformed Church of Sully, Iowa. He often told of crossing the Atlantic in 1864 when the trip required 60 days. A cholera epidemic broke out on board ship and all passengers were detained at Ellis Island for several days, their personal property and clothing burned before they were allowed to continue their journey.

He was a farmer and lived most of his married life in Jasper county, first on a farm north of Sully and later near Kellogg. A member of The Daily News Three Quarter Century club, he was the second oldest member present at the 1954 meeting but was unable to be present at the 1955 meeting.

Will Klyn, Sr., of Killduff passed away Sunday evening, February 5, at the home of his daughter and son-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. J. S. Adams, where he had been making his home since 1947.
